ORDERED that the motion be, and the same hereby is, **GRANTED** pursuant to Maryland Rule 15-504(a), conditioned on the posting of bond in the amount of $\frac{7500.00}{7500.00}$, on the grounds that immediate, substantial, and irreparable harm will result to Petitioner's goodwill with wholesalers and distributors who sell other brands manufactured by S&M Brands if S&M Brands is removed from the Maryland Tobacco Directory; and it is further

ORDERED that S&M Brands shall not be removed from the Maryland Tobacco Dirrectory for as long as this order is in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that any party or person affected by this Order may apply for modification or dissolution of the Order on two days' notice to Petitioner, and it is further

ORDERED that this Order shall expire on 324, 2019 at 4:30a.m. (p.m.) which date is not later than ten (10) days after the issuance of this Order; and, on motion filed pursuant to Maryland Rule 1-204, the court by order may extend the expiration date for no more than one additional like period, unless Petitioner consents to an extension for a longer period.
